

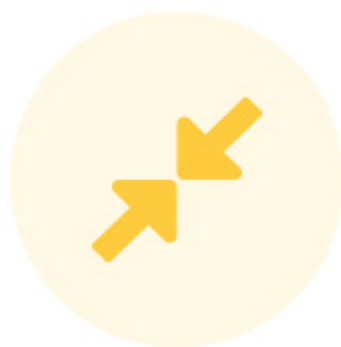

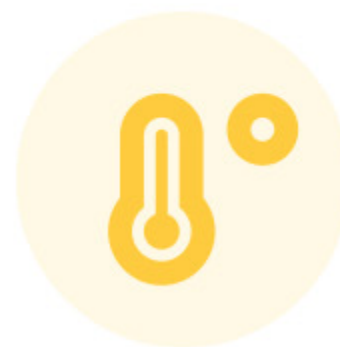
Hazards of working in roofs

hazards**



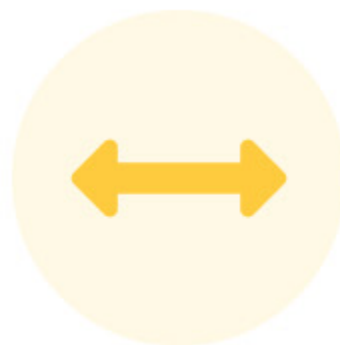
**Cramped working

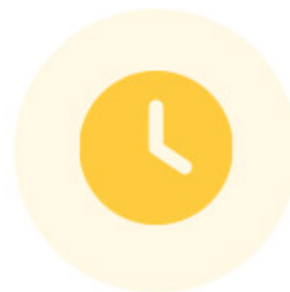
Controls to reduce the risks of working in roofs in the heat:



**Mechanical aids
to reduce strain**



**Mechanical fans
in roof cavities**



**Reduce time spent
working in heat**



**Work in cooler
parts of the day**



**Shaded, cool
rest area**



**Schedule
extra breaks**



**Cool drinking
water is available**



**Encourage wearing
light-weight clothes**

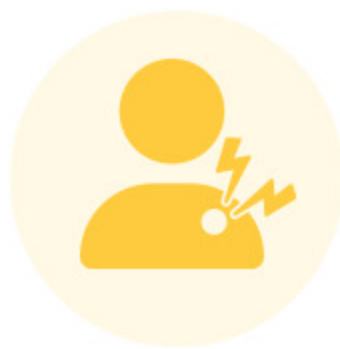
