What supervisors can do:

-  build a positive workplace culture
-  know your organisation's processes for workers' compensation
-  be supportive
-  lead by example
-  communicate early and regularly

What workers can do:

-  show support
-  call out bad behaviour
-  check in
-  listen
-  talk openly and honestly

What employers can do:

-  raise awareness of workers' compensation
-  make information available on how to access workers' compensation
-  build leadership capability
-  provide support services for all staff
-  have clear policies for reporting an injury or illness
