## **ELECTRICITY REGULATORS**

Technical and safety electrical regulatory functions are largely the responsibility of state and territory Electricity Regulators who regulate electrical safety and standards through the administration of Electricity Acts, Regulations, Codes of Practice, guidance material and electrical licensing.
